I will write your story too.

She came under my window again, we watched each other again, we talked again, but silence set in quickly, everything was too much of an effort and it ended that way. I need her close presence, but we pretend it is not OK.

“Will you see each other again”, I asked him.

“Oh, sure, we will. What else will I do? We can write to each other, but I feel as that boy in a movie, who lives in a balloon, because his immune system is terrible. You know, there is a logic which we have to follow, there is moral and ethics, and there is what we want in order to feel alive. I know it is logical to make a cable car on every mountain, but I will rather get tired climbing it. It makes us different and I wish life is not stopped due to our safety. That has never functioned and it never will because something else will come up, and as always we hide from problems when we don't know how to solve them. I respect the rules because this is a global problem, I will not show revolt, not yet.”

“Wait... you are both young, why is it that you cannot while she can be outside?”

“You see, it is our insanity. We are same age, but I am still a minor, since my birthday is in December, while she already celebrated her birthday this year, and that is our logic, a mass not individuals, it is too complicated for us.”

I watched him from the same place, where she stood, a couple of hours before. And he was right, perhaps a bit naive kind of thinking but I figured out his point. The point is that logic has to be adjusted to situations and needs.

I feel the society, in the moments of crisis, behaves as a feudal system, where we all had a low social class of people, who are constantly doing badly, but they live... while higher classes of people do not feel the crisis, but uses it in any way they know, at the expense of the poor.

I cannot ignore what is happening, I watch TV, I watch how furniture production companies, cake-shops and companies that produce juices sell their souls to the system in order to trick their way to the future and ensure financial benefits, at the expense of those whom they used to belong to themselves.



But, that is all OK, no one is in panic when those things happen, because it all looks like a part of a plan and it is all behind it, just as we see people having parties on the mountains near Sarajevo, because they can. Those are the same people who keep us under control, but they live their lives based on what they think is OK. If I sit on the street, today, to protest against those things, the entire town would attack me because I interfere with their... I'll call it life, they would all lose their minds, they would all join in attacking me, and that is the only way they know how to cooperate. How to define the limit between protecting people and repression, in the form of freedom of movement ban? I understand the problem, I am not selfish and I think of others... But to what point is all that reasonable if, at one moment, I realize that I harm myself directly? What is the use of it if we are all in a hibernation state, where time goes by while our lives are stalled?

“Have you seen each other, again?” I asked him the next day.

“We have. I went out last night, after my father fell asleep. I took her hand, for the first time in two months, luckily we were in our

building hallway, since she also lives in the same building. I saw you taking picture of us this morning, could you publish the photo somewhere?”

THE FIRST CAT DIGITAL ACADEMY

The first CAT Digital Academy started to work on Monday, June 22!

In cooperation with distinguished youth professionals from Serbia, Ivana Volf and Marinela Sumanski, we present to you our first Digital Academy for social networks managers!





The Digital Academy includes 24 most motivated young social network managers from civil society organizations in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

We talked to Marinela and Ivana about how the first meeting with the participants was.

“The meeting, which took place in the Zoom, went very well, almost all participants joined us, at this first gathering, which, at the same time, served as a kick-off of the entire Academy. The participants were, at the beginning, shy, however, they soon relaxed and started to communicate. The atmosphere was getting relaxed as well so we started to joke around and create stronger bonds among the participants and the coaches. The participants got interested in and motivated to work on a topic, while a few came with clear goals about what it is that they want to learn, advance and why.” – Marinela and Ivana told catbih.ba.

What was done with the participants, at the first meeting?

“We gave an introduction, at the first meeting, and wished them a welcome, explained them the background of the Academy and the CAT, our goals and expectations from us, as educators and organizers. We explained to them the program elements of all four modules, as well as the methodology and tools we are going to use in our work. Also, at our first meeting, we presented ourselves to each other, in an interactive way, using the Jamboard tool, we shared a bit about each of us and broke the ice in the group. At the end, we talked about our next steps which we plan to make in the forthcoming period, at the Academy, within the scope of our first module. We, also, answered participants' questions related to the content and technical aspects of the Academy and its work”. Marinela and Ivana said.

What are the plans for your next session?

“Our next session will be held by using the Dicord tool, where the participants have a task to register and create short profiles using a digital card, and in that way present themselves in a more thorough way to the group. Also, we will ask them to express their expectations, challenges and what they can offer to others during the Academy. After that, we will go through a session of building a team and the introduction to the topic of online campaigns, through a conversation about key words and understanding relevant expressions.” – Marinela and Ivana told catbih.ba

What are your impressions and expectations?

“We expect that we will meet the students' needs, that their learning adventure with us will be fun and useful, and that it will be dedicated to the Academy. We expect them to feel free to ask for help whenever they need it in order to make the results better.” Marinela and Ivana told catbih.ba

Daily workshops

The Youth Organization „Svitac“ has continued with its daily activities, following the regular schedule. The first group of participants, is on the schedule from 11:00 to 13:00, ages 4-7. The second group is on the schedule from 14:00 to 15:30, ages 8+. Our young participants worked on creative and educational things, during workshops adjusted to their age, supported by local and



international volunteers. This month they worked on the following: drawing various animals using hands and fingers, „Jagodica bobica“ and other cherry fruits, stories and songs about friendship, hardworking busy bees and about a tiny virus. They continued to practice alphabet, learned to write letters O, P, R and words which start with those letters. They drew expressions which start with a certain letter. During our music workshops, they learned a song called „A little bear and honey“, and a song about numbers in English, German, French and BHC languages. Just like during previous months „Svitac, within the scope of its regular activities, intensively, worked on the topic of hygiene and paid special attention to it. The aim of those activities, at it has previously been the case, is to help children develop imagination, and, by using different materials, develop motoric skills, tolerance and respect for others as well as kind behavior.

The participants of the other workshop (14:00-15:30), ages 8+, worked hard on various activities. During this month, we created a joint play list. This month, we, also, asked them to show us how they feel by using GIFs, and created small energizers.

This month, we completed a small online project, in which, each participant says „Freedom is expensive“, in a foreign language (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=GtgxhNR2KTM>). This way, we wanted to draw attention to the fact that we are not aware how much our freedom means to us and that we often forget little things, which make our lives prettier and fuller. This video was shared on social networks run by the Youth Organization „Svitac“.

Adin Midzic coordinated those workshops, assisted by local, Weltwärts and EVS/ESC international volunteers.

Guitar workshops

The participants have continued with workshops. The videos shared, on the official Facebook page of the Youth Organization „Svitac“, are the following: Vrapcicu, Cantilena (D. Godanovic) and Lettre a soi meme (Roland Dyens).

Samba workshops

The participants of this workshop were preparing short educational clips for the group Facebook page. Video clips were produced by the German – French TV station ARTE. Apart from this, they posted video clips, shot for the purpose of archiving, further composing and work on compositions.



ECO – project

The members of the Eco project and the members of the local AsuBiH team, have continued with their work, talked about plans for future activities and interactive workshops.

World Parents Day

The United Nations General Assembly, in the Resolution passed in 2012, proclaimed June 1 as the World Parents Day.

The World Parents Day is an important reminder of values and importance of a family. Also, we recognize and value the importance of parents who, unselfishly, with their own example, put daily efforts in developing and protection of the youngest members of our society. It underlines the importance of parents' role as well.

The Youth Organization „Svitac“ marked this day, with its youngest members, through a story called „Porodica Oblacic“ („Family Called Little Cloud“), which speaks of family happiness, care and the importance of parents' role.

World Day of Environment Protection

Each year, June 5 is being marked as the World Day of Environment Protection. It is an anniversary of the United Nations Conference, held in Stockholm in 1972, dedicated to environment, when the UN Environment Protection Program (UNEP) was adopted.

We can make little steps, on this day, but also any other day, in order to preserve our only home.

Let's use bikes more, walk more, and use water with care and plant trees and flowers.

The Youth Organization „Svitac“ marked this day with participants, ages 15+, at the workshop held outdoors.



We talked about ecology and ways how to contribute to the protection of our environments. The participants, also, wrote motivational messages about our only home.

World Day against Child Labor

The World Day against Child Labor is marked on June 12. Our duty is to protect children, not only on this day, but always, from abuse. The Youth Organization „Svitac“ marked this day with participants, ages 4 to 7, at the workshop adjusted to their age. We talked about children’s’ rights and how all children, around the world, should have a safe home and beautiful childhood.

World Refugees Day

The United Nations General Assembly pronounced June 20 as the „World Refugees Day“, which is nowadays marked all over the world.

The Youth Organization „Svitac“ held a workshop, at which we read stories, for children ages 4 to 7, about animals who live together in friendship in a deep forest. The animals had to leave their home, because one mean badger had come with his friends and wanted the entire forest for himself. The story had a happy ending. All little animal friends have found new homes, in a new forest with a lake. The story and the working method were adjusted to their age. At the end of the workshop, they got a task to draw a personal item they would take with them to a travel. We, also, concluded that we, always, have to help persons who lost their homes and share clothes and food with them.

Centar Sarajevo municipality will get a new Strategy for youth



The Institute for Development of Youth and Centar Sarajevo municipality signed a contract, today, on mutual cooperation related to creating a new Strategy for Youth, in this municipality, for the period 2021 – 2025. A research about the needs and problems of the youth, in this municipality, will precede drafting the Strategy. It is important to emphasize that the Institute, 10 years ago, conducted the same research, in the area of this municipality, so it will be interesting to compare results and see the development during the past 10 years.

Mr Nedžad Ajnadžić, the Mayor of the municipality, Mr Jasmin Bešić, the General Director of the Institute, municipal administration representatives and representatives of the Institute's Department for monitoring, evaluation and research were present, at the meeting, when the agreement was signed.

All the attendees expressed great satisfaction due to this cooperation and joint work on drafting a new strategic document meant for the youth.

The strategy for the youth is a legal obligation of all local communities' units, in the area of the Federation of BiH, in accordance to the BiH Law on Youth, adopted in 2010. At the time, the Institute for Development of Youth KULT worked on this Law, as well.

During last week, the Institute for Development of Youth KULT, issued a public invitation to all local communities' units in BiH, to apply for co-financing the creation of strategic documents for the young, which is their legal obligation. The institute will, in the forthcoming period, support creating strategies for the youth in other municipalities as well. The first steps of the research, in Sarajevo Centar municipality, have been made already.

There are companies in BiH which support corporate volunteering

Corporate volunteering is a kind of social engagement which is planned, organized and conducted by a company employees, approved and supported by a company management. During corporate volunteering, employees spend one or more working days working as volunteers, conducting tasks for social benefit. Employers treat those days as working days, without reducing the income or days off, to those employees who spend them working as volunteers. This way, companies express their social responsibility and get to know better the environment in which they conduct their businesses.



Even though, at first, this sounds almost impossible, there are companies in BiH which support and practice corporate volunteering. Drogerie Markt (DM) is one of the examples. Their employees have one working day, in a year, which they can use for volunteering work of their own choice. The Institute for Development of Youth KULT has launched systemic support to development and promotion of this kind of volunteering activities. The Institute has launched an online platform **volontiraj.ba** which enables associations and companies to connect, in the area of corporate volunteering.

The platform has been developed, within the scope of the „Improving human rights in the BiH economic sector“ initiative, implemented by the Institute for Development of Youth, supported by the European Union.

Amel Tuka thought UMiD Kids members about the importance of discipline in achieving supreme results



Those who have achieved supreme results know best about how important discipline is, in this respect. One of them is Amel Tuka, the best BiH athlete and one of the best athletes in the world. Amel spent one afternoon with UMiD Kids training and teaching them how discipline is important in the lives of all of us.

UMiD Kids is an educational – interactive program for kids, and consists of 12 modules related to topics important for intellectual, emotional and social development

of a child. The aim of this program is to make children more self-confident, have better connection with parents, school, and friends and to gain a broader and clearer picture of themselves, others and the world they live in, to develop sense of themselves and others.

Amel emphasized that socializing with kids was pleasant and fun and praised their interest. He was patient and answered each of their questions. Amel added that spending time with children is a resting experience for him and that he tries to spend as much of his free time with kids as he can.

In order to teach the kids what discipline in sport is, in practice, he organized a short race with them. They learned how to behave when they win, and how to accept defeat and learn lessons from those experiences.

UMiD Kids is implemented by the Institute for Development of Youth KULT, and attended by kids, ages 8 to 10. All expenses of trainings are free of charge for their parents, thanks to the Embassy of the Kingdom of Netherlands in BiH.

The Agency for Youth and Development CEREBRA Banja Luka, in the period between June 25 – 26, 2020, held an online conference „You Can Youth Can“, via the Zoom platform.
